Firstly, we visit Punkva Caves in Moravian Karst, the most important karst area of Central Europe. You can see there the bottom of the famous Macoch Abyss and undertake romantic cruise on the underground Punkva river. Hundreds of thousands of people from all over the world visit these caves.

Then we continue to small village Krtiny with its pilgrimage church of the Name of Virgin Mary designed by Giovanni Santini. It was built in the 18th century in unique style called baroque Gothic style. The ancient Marian pilgrimage place in Krtiny prospered a lot during the top baroque period. More than 50 000 pilgrims used to visit it yearly that time.
